Please find below information about the following autumn course:

- **Hebrew ALEF Kehillah North London 10 Week Course** (once a week)
- Level: Beginners 1
- Course level description: This is the breakthrough level. You will learn the alphabet, cursive and block letters, use the present tense in 4 conjugations, acquire basic conversational skills, build verbal and nominal sentences as well as useful questions for daily use.
- Starts (UK): 12/10/2020
- Ends (UK): 14/12/2020
- Day: Mondays
- Time (UK): 18:30-20:00

General FAQs:

- How do I know I am at the right level?
Beginners 1 requires no previous knowledge of Hebrew, though some students have learned a bit by themselves, but this is not a requirement in any way.
- Do I need a course book?
No, all the material of the course, including a PDF of the book, class presentations and audios will be provided to you by the teacher, following the payment for the course.
- What is the teaching method?
The teaching method is following the book recommended by the Hebrew University, Hebrew from Scratch, integrated with some more updated materials which will be used during the class presentations and homework.
- Will I have homework?
Yes, repetition is an essential part of learning a new language. You are not obligated to do your homework, but it will improve your learning substantially if you do. Homework will be sent via the WhatsApp course group, which will also be used for sharing audio files and any additional material. If you do not use WhatsApp, you can ask to be sent the homework via e-mail.
- What if I will be missing a lesson?



Please inform Matan in advance. The classes are online, on Zoom, and are recorded upon consensus of the other students, so that those who miss can review the lesson recording.

- How big are the classes and what is the price?

Classes must be small, between 4-10 students. The price for a 15 hours course is 150£.

- How do I make the payment?

I accept making the first half (75£) before the course starts, and the other half in the middle of the course (before 16 November).

- What is included in the price?

Except for the lessons and the materials, you can send the writing assignments to Matan before the lesson, and you will get it corrected so you can learn from your mistakes. The homework is regularly checked together at the beginning of each lesson.

- What is the refund policy?
